

**YOUTH ALPHA**  
**FEEDBACK FROM**  
**LEADERS**

Being part of the leadership team in Youth Alpha, I can see drastic changes in some of the youths. I can see that their we, leaders, advisors and youth get to bond more than usual during our normal youth session. We got to talk more about our life situation and how we can “talk things out” in groups and get to know more about each other. Besides bonding, we also got to reaffirm our faith in Christ through the videos. There’s time we youths found ourselves backsliding due to family issues, peer pressure from school, relationship problems, addiction and many, many more issues and we have totally no idea on how to face all these issues. Videos from the Youth Alpha Video Session greatly help us in reminding that we still have Jesus that we can totally depend on and that we should **“Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.”** 1 Peter 5:7. The leaders also got to learn how to lead small group of youths and how to minister them. It was a breakthrough for some of us that we got to pray for the youths and allow them to encounter God. There’s youth who got healed after the ministering session and some even felt the presence of Holy Spirit that they never encounter before. From all of this, we learned how to lead as a team and that leading is not a “one man show”. Even though at times, we do have different opinions on certain stuff and our opinion may cause some heaty discussion but that’s what a team was meant to be, talk things out and solve everything *together* and to love each with the love of Christ. Furthermore, relationship between advisors and youths have greatly increase after attending Youth Alpha. Advisors can know what the youths are currently facing with their lives during small chit-chats and discussion and how the advisors can help and pray for them. The food was superb and delicious and I can’t thank the advisors enough for their ability to get such good food. Finally, everything has a start and there’s an end for it. It has been some superb, fun, challenging and faithful 12 weeks of fellowship together in Youth Alpha. The past 12 weeks were not all fun and easy, but knowing how the leadership team (including the advisors and pastor) had each other's back, I believe that it has strengthen our relationship with each other as well. I do think alpha was a success not just because of the large numbers we had but the stronger relationship each of us have with God.
